Getting into a club

Students can attend clubs on a first come, first serve basis.

Teachers running the club will take a register for attendees on the day for their club. For clubs running after school only students who have been registered will be considered present in school. Students not registered in a club should have made arrangements to return home as per normal.

Clubs will in some cases have a maximum attendee number. Once the club is full for that session, then further students will be unable to attend that session. Some clubs have invited students only.
