Government Recognition for Outstanding GCSE Attainment at Oakgrove Once Again

The sun was certainly shining on Oakgrove students when they received their GCSE results and were congratulated by Schools Minister Lord Agnew. An impressive 76.5% of students achieved grades 9 - 4 in English and Mathematics, with over 20% of all GCSEs being graded 9-7.

The student's strong performance in their GCSEs means that Oakgrove will have the highest number ever of its own pupils joining its sixth form for further study.

Oakgrove School's Headteacher, Ian Tett, said:

"Student's excellent work ethic, the high-quality teaching of our staff and the continued support from parents have all contributed to this year's well-deserved GCSE results."
