Curriculum development support from MKSSP

Purchasing of high quality resources

**Summary of spending and actions taken:**

Whole staff CPD training session (Nov 16) delivered to develop consistent approach to PE teaching across school

PE Co-ordinator support from MKSSP throughout year, including developing action plan

Curriculum planning developed (Oct 16) and deployed to support staff to teach effective lessons with clear progression across year groups

MKSSP resourcing Audit undertaken (Dec 16) and additional resources purchased to support staff to deliver PE more effectively

HQ PE lessons delivered by MKSSP with CPD support

After School Sports Clubs and activities provided to children throughout year

New assessment procedure developed and deployed (Mar 17)

**Outcomes to date:**

A range of after-school sports clubs were offered and were well attended.(%)

Learning walks for PE undertaken to monitor and observe PE teaching indicate that PE teaching is consistently strong across the age range. This reflects the impact of the CPD sessions, the curriculum development, the resource audit and subsequent purchasing and the CPD support offered by MKSSP.

The PE assessment system which was developed, is used by teachers to measure the progress of individuals over time and informs the curriculum planning, leading to the effective teaching of PE.

Sports day was hugely successful, with 293 adults attending as supporter and 217 children taking part.

One of the key outcomes of the development plan was the appointment of a specialist Teacher of Sport for a September 2017 start

## **Objectives in spending PE & Sport Grant for 2017-18**

- Ensure over 60% of children have the opportunity to attend an after-school sports club
- School participates in at least 6 MKSSP competitive festivals across the year and that after-school clubs are linked to competitive festivals
- Develop an area of the website to celebrate and share our PE and sports provision
- Plan and resource a project to ensure we develop a creative and innovative approach to delivering 30 minutes a day of moderate to vigorous activity for all pupils
- Create a culture of participation, ensuring that all groups of pupils participate and enjoy PE and sport
