<b>Exploring flags</b> Can you draw flags for different countries? What colours are they? What patterns do they have? You may also write sentences or key words to describe the flags.	
<b>Pairing numbers to make 10 and/or 20</b> Can you write down pairs of numbers which add up to 10 or 20? You may wish to use objects and your fingers to help you.	
<b>Multiplication game</b> Roll a dice, what number does it land on? Can you multiply it by 2, 5 and 10? Can you draw these in groups? Can you write the full number sentences?	
<b>Draw an animal and label things about it</b> Can you draw an animal? Where does it live? Can it be kept as a pet? What does it eat? Is it a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore?	
<b>Countries fact file</b> Write some sentences or key words about different countries. What food do they eat? What clothes do they wear? What festivals do they celebrate? What is the weather like?	
<b>Straight line art work</b> Create a piece of artwork using straight lines. How are you going to make sure the lines are straight? Are you going to use anything to help you?	
<b>Weighing challenge</b> Can you use weighing scales to weigh objects or ingredients? How much do they weigh? Can you read the scales accurately?
