Fill in all the main features using words to describe the person. Find a portrait of someone in a magazine or print off the image. Write over the portrait with words that relate to the person in colour. Use different lettering styles and different sizes of letters.</p> <p>Create a close up drawing of an eye. Put in as much detail as possible, you could use colours or shade it in using a range of tones.</p> <p>Create a series of silhouette portraits of four people in your family or four friends. Colour the image in so you have a solid image.</p>
Year 8	<p>Identity: Choose your favourite room in your house and complete a detailed drawing in pencil.</p> <p>Collect your favourite five objects that you own. Draw each object in detail using a pen so the page is full of your drawings.</p> <p>Choose one of your favourite items and draw it many different directions to create a cubist style image, then colour or tone to your final piece of work.</p> <p>Re-design your favourite object to make it function better. Change the colours and shape.</p>
Year 9	<p>The Coast :</p> <p>Create your own sketchbook (it needs to have four pages). Decorate the cover with images that relate to the coast You can draw, collage or a combination of both.</p> <p>Design 4 postcard based on the coast using the images to inspire your designs, you could work in colour or in tone. Your postcards must be eye-catching and show a range of detail. Add a name of a coastal area you have heard of or visited.</p>

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Geography

Key Stage 3

Year 7	We are currently studying UK waves at work. Students study erosion and deposition processes and landforms, coastal management and the conflict they caused. Students are to produce an assessed piece of work on 'Which coastal management option is best for the UK coast?'. Lesson plans and resources will be added to Google Classroom for students.
Year 8	We are currently studying Sub-Saharan Africa. Students study the Horn of Africa and piracy, barriers to development, the Kibera squatter settlement and how we can improve development there. The last topic that will be covered is disease (Ebola, Malaria and HIV). Students should also make sure that they have completed their project on a chosen country/theme in Sub-Saharan Africa, this has already been set and explained to them. Lesson plans and resources will be added to Google Classroom for students.
Year 9	We are currently studying China. Students study industrialisation, Foxconn and Apple, what life is like for those working in factories and how it could be improved. Students will then undertake an end of topic assessment on all that has been learnt on the China topic since January. Once finished, students will focus on their key geographical skills and complete the booklet provided. Lesson plans and resources will be added to Google Classroom for students.

Year 10	We are currently studying 'The UK's evolving human landscape'. Students are studying London as the key case study for this topic. They will need to cover London's structure, migration, inequality, deindustrialisation, regeneration and the 2012 Olympics, rebranding Newham, sustainable London. Students will also cover rural-urban fringe and life in Terling, Devon and finally, challenges and opportunities facing Cornwall. Lesson plans and resources will be added to Google Classroom for students as well as Kerboodle (online textbook), GCSEPod and Seneca Learning online to aid students.
Year 11	We are currently completing the final topic of the GCSE course, 'Consuming Energy Resources'. Students need to cover different energy resources and their environmental impacts, how we access energy resources, renewable energy potential in the UK, global energy use, how much oil there is and the changing price of it as a resource. Students need to learn case studies on Athabasca tar sands, Gazprom and the arctic, how London's carbon footprint can be reduced. Finally, students what the future looks like. Lesson plans and resources will be added to Google Classroom for students as well as Kerboodle (online textbook), GCSEPod and Seneca Learning online to aid students.

Year 10	<p>Biology Synergy - students have just started cells in animals in plants. This includes: cell structure, magnification, transport substance in and out of cells and mitosis and meiosis. Students will then study systems in the human body. This includes: respiration, the circulatory system, the digestive system and the nervous system.</p> <p>Chemistry Synergy - have just started Atomic Structure, this will be followed by The Earth's Atmosphere then The Periodic Table.</p> <p>Physics Synergy - no students currently studying Physics Synergy.</p> <p>Biology - Trilogy - students have just started B1 - Cells. This includes: understanding differences between animal and plant cells, specialised cells, prokaryotes, magnification, mitosis and the cell cycle and diffusion osmosis and active transport. After this students look at B2 which involves: tissues and organs and the digestive system.</p> <p>Chemistry - Trilogy- have just started C1- Atomic Structure & the periodic table, will then be doing C2 Bonding & Structure, appropriate resources will be available for students.</p> <p>Physics - Trilogy - students have just started P1 - Energy, this is to include: understanding kinetic energy, gravitational potential energy, internal energy and elastic potential energy equations.</p> <p>Biology - Triple - students will be starting B4 - Respiration and Photosynthesis.</p> <p>Chemistry - Triple - Students are currently studying C4 – Chemical changes - Reactions of acid and will then move onto Electrolysis - appropriate resources will be available for students.</p> <p>Physics - Triple - Students will need to complete P3 'Particle Model of Matter', this includes: understanding the structure and characteristics of solids, liquids and gases, gas pressure, Boyle's Law.</p>
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<p>Year 11</p>	<p>Biology - Trilogy - students are starting B6 - Inheritance and variation. This includes: DNA, inheritance of characteristics, genetic diseases e.g. cystic fibrosis, punnett squares, genome project and evolution by natural selection and it's evidence.</p> <p>Chemistry - Trilogy - students will be starting C10 - The Earth and its resources, students can then move onto C8 - Chemical Analysis - appropriate resources will be available for students</p> <p>Physics - Trilogy - students have started P5 - Forces. Students will need to understand Newton's 3 Laws of motion, conservation of momentum, stopping distances of moving objects. Once completed, students will be moving onto P6 - Waves. This includes: understanding the differences between transverse and longitudinal waves and uses and properties of all the waves within the electromagnetic spectrum.</p> <p>Biology - Synergy - Students are finishing lifestyle and health, this involves the reproductive system, contraception and treatment of infertility. Students will then be moving onto preventing, treating and curing diseases.</p> <p>Chemistry - Synergy - Students are currently on 4.7.5 Atoms into ions and ions into atoms, then will be moving onto 4.8.1 Carbon Chemistry.</p> <p>Physics - Synergy - Students are currently looking at waves. This includes: understanding transverse and longitudinal waves, uses and applications of the electromagnetic spectrum and the wave equation.</p> <p>Biology Triple - Students only have decomposition and food production (biotechnology and sustainable fishing and farming) left to study. After this, students will be given revision resources to complete.</p> <p>Chemistry Triple - Students have just started C10 The Earth and its' resources - resources will be made available. After this, students need to move on to revision, past papers can be found on the AQA Chemistry website.</p> <p>Physics Triple - Students will be starting P7 'Magnetism and electromagnetism'. This is to include the motor effect and its related equation. The last topic P8 'Space' includes understanding the life cycle of a star.</p>
