

Art and Design

Art and Design at Oakgrove School is taught to all KS3 students for one hour per week.

The projects completed are designed to widen students' knowledge of techniques and materials, and introduce them to contemporary and traditional artists. All students will have the opportunity to improve practical art skills through the use of a range of media.

Year 7

Students will learn about the application of colour, tone, mark making, perspective and observational drawings. All students will investigate a range of artists that link to the areas of study: Helen Wells, Cézanne, Micael Graig, Martin Lou Taylor. There will be the opportunity for students to build on these skills when working on individual pieces.

Year 8

Students will build on the skills taught during Year 7. All students will look at Art from other cultures focusing on meaning, colour pattern and the influence on World Art. The students will also look at the impact of Cubism in the Art World. They will use observational images to develop final pieces inspired by Artists such as Picasso. The projects will use a range of media such as paint, collage, clay, cardboard and digital media to emulate the movement. They will independently investigate a culture such as Day of the Dead, Aboriginal Art or Traditional Japanese Art

Year 9

Students will be introduced to the GCSE in Art and Design. They will work on three main projects. The Seaside, The Circus and Sweet Treats. The key areas of focus will be drawing and capturing images, painting and taking photographs, experimenting with materials using print, making clay, digital manipulation and textiles. Students will continue to complete artist research, investigating artists and designers and creating work inspired by them. Students will finish the year presenting a personal response, using all of the above to produce an informed piece of Artwork.
