Dear students & parents/carers,

I hope that you are enjoying your summer and are looking forward to September. Please find below the details of how you will receive results and what you need to do over the following days.

GCSE Results Day:

We know that August may seem a long way away but I wanted to inform you of our plans for GCSE results day on Thursday 22nd August. In order to be able to prioritise the advice, guidance and support that we offer students, we will continue to send the results to students electronically. Senior leaders, the Sixth Form team, and our Careers Advisor will all be in school and on hand to offer help by phone, email, or in person if needed. This process has worked very effectively over recent years and frees up staff time to focus on students needing guidance most.

Students will receive their GCSE and BTEC results electronically through an email to the students' Oakgrove email account at about 9 am on Thursday 22nd August.

Post-16

Students will then receive another email at about the same time as their results. This email will contain a letter letting them know whether they have met the entrance criteria for Oakgrove Sixth Form and for their chosen courses. Within this letter there will be a link to a google form that **all** Year 11 students have to complete. This will allow students to let us know if they have received their exam results, confirm their place at Oakgrove Sixth Form, make subject changes, request a call back from a member of staff, and also let us know their next steps if not continuing at Oakgrove. The Careers team have to report Post-16 destinations to the local authority in September. This is a legal requirement failure to fill out the form will result in the Careers team making calls home.

Please note that students need to have confirmed their place at Oakgrove Sixth Form by 3pm on 31st August. Failure to do so may result in a place not being available.

Passport to Sixth Form:

Please note that, for both internal and external applicants, students will receive an email in the afternoon of the 8th July with 'Passport to Sixth Form' work. The instructions will accompany this email and the work will need to be completed by all successful applicants by the start of term in September.
